(1) Some shares are subject to restrictions and forfeiture under Company Stock Benefit Plan.

The number of shares to be received will depend on the Company's relative Total Shareholder Return (TSR) for the 3-year period beginning on January 1, 2008, which will be evaluated against the TSR over the same 3-year period for a pre-set group of approximately 30 peer companies. Total Shareholder Return is calculated by adding the changes in a company's closing stock price between December 30, 2007 and December 31, 2010 to any dividends paid during that period, and is adjusted for any stock splits or dividends.
