We generated revenues of approximately \$8,448,000 and \$11,771,000 for the quarters ended September 30, 2017 and 2016, respectively and \$21,807,000 and \$24,537,000 for the nine months ended September 30, 2017 and 2016, respectively. Total sorbent product sales for the three months ended September 30, 2017 and 2016 were \$8,076,000 and \$11,453,000, respectively. Total sorbent product sales for the nine months ended September 30, 2017 and 2016 were \$20,472,000 and \$21,163,000, respectively. The decrease in product sales is primarily due to customer optimization efforts and negotiated price decreases with our customers.

For the quarter ended September 30, 2017 we had net income of approximately \$869,000. For the quarter ended September 30, 2016, we had a net loss of approximately \$9,302,000. For the nine months ended September 30, 2017 and 2016 we had net income of \$95,000 and a net loss of \$16,636,000, respectively. The change in net income is primarily due to the change in value of warrant liability.
