On October 19, 2005, Team, Inc. (the "Company") entered into an agreement settling the pending litigation styled Diamond Shamrock Refining Company, L.P. v. Puffer-Sweiven, Inc. et al in the 36th Judicial District Court of Live Oak County, Texas, Cause number L-05-0093-CV-A. The entire settlement is being funded by the Company's insurance carriers. However, indemnity coverage from the \$1 million primary policy remains in dispute in an action styled Team Industrial Services, Inc. v. American Safety Indemnity Company et. al . in the 149th Judicial District Court of Brazoria County, Texas, Cause number 28,400. The Company remains confident that it will prevail in establishing its right to indemnity in that case, having already won its rights to a defense by the carrier in the same matter.
