Item 1.01 Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement.

On February 9, 2005, Digital Realty Trust, Inc. (the *Company*), the general partner of Digital Realty Trust, L.P. (the *Operating Partnership*), entered into the Second Amended and Restated Agreement of Limited Partnership of Digital Realty Trust, L.P. (as so amended, the *Partnership Agreement*). The Partnership Agreement was entered into in connection with the issuance by the Operating Partnership to the Company of 4,140,000 series A preferred units in the Operating Partnership (the *Preferred Units*). The Preferred Units have substantially similar rights, preferences and other privileges as the 4,140,000 shares of 8.50% Series A Cumulative Redeemable Preferred Stock (the *Series A Preferred Stock*) issued on February 9, 2005 by the Company pursuant to a registration statement, as amended (File No. 333-122099), originally filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on January 18, 2005. The Partnership Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit 10.2 and is incorporated by reference herein.

Item 5.03 Amendments to Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws; Change in Fiscal Year.

On February 8, 2005, the Company filed with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation of the State of Maryland an articles supplementary to its charter (the *Articles Supplementary*). The Articles Supplementary classified 4,140,000 unissued shares of Company preferred stock, par value \$0.01 per share, as 8.50% Series A Cumulative Redeemable Preferred Stock. The 4,140,000 shares of Series A Preferred Stock have the preferences and other rights, voting powers, restrictions, limitations as to dividends, qualifications, and terms and conditions of redemption as set forth in the Articles Supplementary. The Articles Supplementary are attached hereto as Exhibit 3.3 and are incorporated by reference herein.

Item 8.01 Other Events

On February 9, 2005, Digital Realty Trust, Inc. completed the offering of its 8.50% Series A Cumulative Redeemable Preferred Stock. Citigroup and UBS Investment Bank, on behalf of the underwriters of the offering, exercised their over-allotment option to purchase an additional 540,000 shares of Series A Preferred Stock. Including the exercise of the underwriters over-allotment option, the Company issued a total of 4,140,000 shares of Series A Preferred Stock generating gross proceeds of \$103.5 million. A copy of the press release announcing the completion of the offering is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1.
