Item Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement 1.01

LML Patent Corp., an indirect wholly-owned subsidiary of LML Payment Systems Inc. (collectively, the "Registrant"), announced today that it has agreed to the terms of a Settlement and License Agreement (the "Agreement") with PayPal, Inc. with respect to litigation filed by LML in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Texas alleging that PayPal infringed U.S. Patent No. RE40,220 (the "Patent Litigation"). PayPal agreed to pay \$7,500,000 in connection with the Agreement.

The Registrant expects to file the PayPal Agreement as an exhibit to its Annual Report on Form 10-K for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2011. The foregoing description is qualified in its entirety by reference to the complete text of the Agreement when filed.

On March 11, 2011, the Registrant issued a press release announcing the settlement, which release is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1 and incorporated herein by reference.
