On July 15, 2003, Loral Space & Communications Ltd. and certain of its subsidiaries filed voluntary petitions for reorganization under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York and parallel insolvency proceedings in the Supreme Court of Bermuda in which certain partners of KPMG were appointed as joint provisional liquidators.

On December 3, 2003, the SpainSat satellite, under construction by Space Systems/Loral, Inc. ("SS/L") for a Spanish customer, was accidentally damaged during preparation for transit from a testing facility in Kent, Washington back

to SS/L's facility in Palo Alto, California. The Kent facility is owned by The Boeing Company and used for thermal vacuum testing when SS/L's own thermal vacuum facility is unavailable. SS/L is currently investigating the cause of the accident and assessing the extent of the damage to the satellite and the effect on the satellite's scheduled delivery date. A delay in the satellite's delivery may give rise to penalty payments and termination rights under the satellite construction contract. SS/L believes that the costs to repair the satellite will be covered by insurance.
